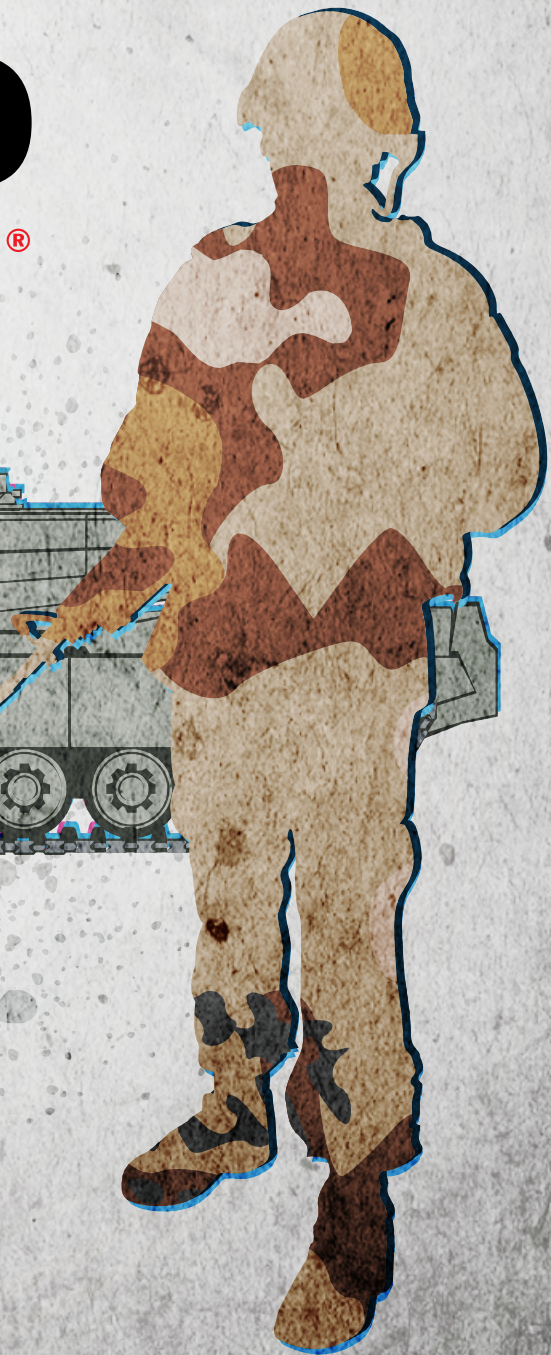
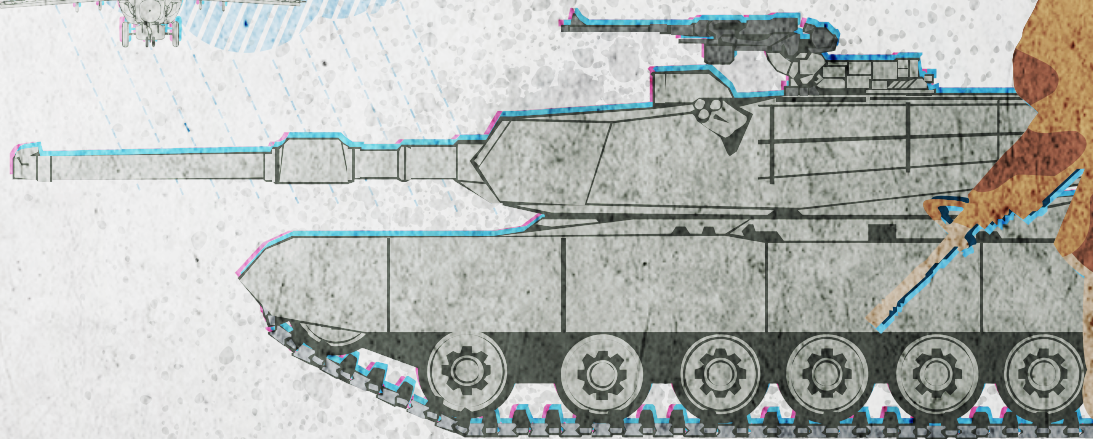
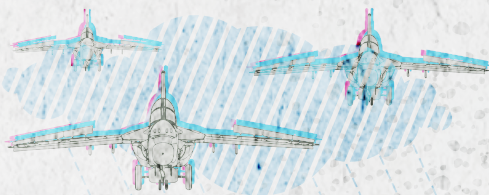

Scubacraft also features an integrated SMB (Surface Marker Buoy) system that indicates its presence underwater to all surface crafts and incorporates an EPIRB (Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon) transmitter. Sounds cool!
